Session I – June 14 – June 18, 2010 – 8AM – 3PM

The focus will be on each player training at his/her technical and tactical edge. Training under pressure and in game simulated environments will be incorporated into every technical and tactical aspect of preparing these players for their upcoming season. There will also be a brief fitness session to close out each day. It is important that each player come to camp prepared to train hard.
